**ORDINANCE**

*entitled*

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BINGHAMTON, CHAPTER 92, MAYOR, SECTION 92-12, TO ESTABLISH THE SALARY OF THE MAYOR FOR FUTURE TERMS

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Code of the City of Binghamton, Chapter 92, *Mayor*, § 92-12, *Salary established annually*, City Council is required to establish “the mayoral salary structure for additional calendar years”; and

WHEREAS, City Council has elected to establish the mayoral salary structure on a per term basis to be determined in the year before mayoral elections.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Code of the City of Binghamton, Chapter 92, *Mayor*, § 92-12, *Salary established annually*, is hereby repealed and replaced in its entirety as follows:

§ 92-12. Salary established [Amended 12-4-2013 by Ord. 13-95; Amended 12-9, 2020 by Ord. 20-110]

A. The Mayor’s annual salary for 01/01/2022 to 12/31/2025 shall be:

- 2022 \$75,076
- 2023 \$75,827
- 2024 \$76,585
- 2025 \$77,350

B. Prior to 12/31/2024, City Council shall establish the Mayor’s annual salary for the Mayoral term from 01/01/2026 to 12/31/2029. Every four years City Council shall establish the Mayor’s salary, by amending section “A” above, for the next Mayoral term. For example:

<u>Council Establishes Mayor’s Salary Prior To:</u>	<u>For the Mayoral Term:</u>
12/31/2028	01/01/2030 to 12/31/2033
12/31/2032	01/01/2034 to 12/31/2037

This schedule shall continue every four years thereafter.

C. If the Common Council should fail or refuse to establish the Mayor’s annual salary as provided above, then the Mayor’s salary during the affected term shall be increased annually by the average upstate New York consumer

price index (CPI) as determined by the U.S. Department of Labor for the preceding twelve (12) month average as of September 1 prior to the next budget year.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
