A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH FRITO LAY, INC. FOR EMERGENCY CONFINED SPACE RESCUE

WHEREAS, the Binghamton Fire Bureau provides emergency confined space rescue services for a fee; and

WHEREAS, Frito Lay, Inc. has requested a three (3) year contract from December 1, 2020, to November 30, 2023, for this service at the Frito Lay Plant located at 10 Spud Lane, Binghamton, NY 13904; and

WHEREAS, Frito Lay, Inc. will pay \$4,700 per year for the contract; and

WHEREAS, in the event that the Binghamton Fire Bureau is needed, the cost would be an additional \$825 per hour; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has recommended approval the attached contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Frito Lay, Inc. for the City of Binghamton Fire Bureau to provide emergency confined space rescue services in accordance with the attached contract.

MUNICIPAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT EMERGENCY CONFINED SPACE RESCUE

PARTIES:

Frito Lay, Inc., 10 Spud Lane, Binghamton, NY 13904 (Frito Lay)

And

City of Binghamton, Municipal Plaza, 38 Hawley Street, Binghamton, New York 13901 (City)

RECITIALS:

- Frito Lay has a manufacturing complex located at 10 Spud Lane, Binghamton, NY 13904, the property, and desires to provide for first responder rescue in emergency confined space situations.
- The City has a professional fire department which can provide emergency confined space rescue services in compliance with Title 29, Code of Federal Regulations Part 1910.146.

THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Emergency Confined Space Rescue. The City agrees to provide apparatus, appliances and rescue personnel for the furnishing of confined space rescue to the property when notified by telephone, or any other manner of a confined space emergency within the property, except when required personnel and/or resources are already committed to an active call elsewhere, in which case requested assistance will be provided as soon as practicable thereafter. The City will then respond to the emergency without delay and with apparatus, appliances and rescue personnel, and the City will diligently, in every way reasonable, rescue entrapped personnel.

Furthermore, the City's rescue team will conduct on site rescue training at least once a year. Training will include both confined space and high angle training.

- 2. Terms of Agreement. This Agreement shall run for a period of three (3) years from the date of execution, unless terminated as provided herein.
- **3.** Termination of Agreement. This Agreement may be terminated by either party by giving written notice of thirty (30) days prior to the annual anniversary agreement date.
