RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR **AMEND** THE CONTRACT VOLUNTEERS IMPROVING NEIGHBORHOOD ENVIRONMENTS (VINES) FOR FY45 CDBG **FUNDS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Permanent Resolution 19-114, the City of Binghamton entered into a contract with Volunteers Improving Neighborhood Environments (WINES) for the use of FY 45 CDBG funds in an amount not to exceed \$12,500 for the Grow Binghamton Program; and

WHEREAS, the HUD Manager recommends a change in scope of the contract due to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, Volunteers Improving Neighborhood Environments (VINES) would like to reallocate funds to purchase supplies for the home gardens.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to amend the contract, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Volunteers Improving Neighborhood Environments (VINES) in order to change the scope of the contract due to COVID-19 to reallocate funds for home garden supplies in an amount to exceed \$12,500; and that funding will be deducted from budget line CD8676.533515.CDY45 (Human Services) for this purpose.

BUDGET NARRATIVE

Personnel Services:

- The Youth Program Manager is responsible for designing, recruiting for, and implementing Grow Binghamton spends 100% of their time annually on youth programming, including the Grow Binghamton program. (1 position)
- The Program Assistant will assist with Grow Binghamton and Urban Farm and will spend 50% of their time in 2020 on this project. (1 position)
- The Youth Peer Leader (YPL) will work 25 hrs/wk for 12 weeks at \$13/hour. The YPL will be a GB alumnus that demonstrates leadership capabilities. The YPL will work with the Program Manager to develop and implement programming. (1 position)
- Youth in Leadership Tract (Y-LT) will include Crew Leaders (CL) who work 22 hrs/wk for 6 weeks at \$13 per hour and another 30 hours before and after program. The CL will be GB alumni that demonstrate leadership capabilities. The CL will be responsible for supervising teams of crew leaders. Root Crew (RC) will include returning youth that had additional responsibilities and work 20 hrs/wk for 6 weeks at \$12.75/hr. RC and CL are eligible for additional hours of up to 6 hrs/week for an additional 12 weeks as part of the full year employment opportunity. (6 positions)

Operating, Administrative and Other Programming Costs:

- Supplies and materials include general Grow Binghamton supplies, including but not limited to cooking demonstration foods, gloves, first aid, and tee shirts. Supplies and materials also includes lumber, soil, compost and other supplies to put together portable grow bags and raised beds that youth will assemble to provide for families to be able to grow their own food.
- Equipment rental includes a portable toilet for use of youth during program and leader orientation.
- Travel covers bus passes for youth, fuel for VINES' vehicles for transporting youth, and mileage for staff use of personal vehicles for the program.

Please Note:

There are additional salaries and other costs not listed in the budget table, per the instructions in the RFP. These account for the difference between the program budget total on the budget table versus on the Application Cover Sheet.
