
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH
FAIRVIEW RECOVERY SERVICES FOR THE
USE OF CARES ACT COVID-9 RELIEF FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into an agreement with Fairview Recovery Services for CARES ACT Covid-19 relief funds in an amount not to exceed \$86,147 funding for fund coordinated entry and homeless management information systems.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Fairview Recovery Services for CARES ACT Covid-19 relief funds in an amount not to exceed \$86,147 funding for coordinated entry and homeless management information systems; and that funds shall be deducted from budget line CD8760.535002.CVY45 (EDW-PROGRAM) for this purpose.
