
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH
VOLUNTEERS OF AMERICA FOR THE USE OF
CARES ACT COVID-9 RELIEF FUNDS FOR
SHELTER SANITATION

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into an agreement with Volunteers of America for CARES ACT Covid-19 relief funds in an amount not to exceed \$16,000 funding for shelter sanitation.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Volunteers of America for CARES ACT Covid-19 relief funds in an amount not to exceed \$16,000 funding for shelter sanitation; and that funds shall be deducted from budget line CD8760.535002.CVY45 (EDW-PROGRAM) for this purpose.
