AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ENTER INTO A PERMANENT EASEMENT
AGREEMENT WITH NYSEG FOR ELECTRICAL
SERVICES TO THE NEW 911 CELL TOWER AT
ELY PARK GOLF COURSE

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is owner of owner of Ely Park Golf Course, 67 Ridge Street, Binghamton, New York, Parcel No. 144.10-1-1; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to grant a permanent easement to New York State Electric and Gas Corporation ("NYSEG") for electrical services to the new 911 cell tower located at Ely Park Golf Course; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Estimate and Apportionment approved and recommended the easement on May 6, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to grant an easement and to execute all necessary and appropriate documentation, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, to NYSEG for electrical services to the new 911 cell tower located at Ely Park Golf Course.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
