WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into an agreement with the Broome-Tioga Stormwater Coalition for stormwater asset mapping implementation in Broome and Tioga Counties; and

WHEREAS, the Broome-Tioga Stormwater Coalition implements the Small municipal stormwater sewer systems (MS4) Stormwater Management Plans required by the New York State Department of Environmental Protection's Phase II Stormwater Regulations and oversees the utilization and expeditures of funds; and

WHEREAS, the City's cost to participate in this coalition for the 2020 Asset Mapping Program is \$2,200; and

WHEREAS, funds are available for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with the Broome-Tioga Stormwater Coalition for stormwater asset mapping implementation in Broome and Tioga Counties at a cost not to exceed \$2,200, and that funds will be deducted from budget line A1440.54420 (Profesisonal Services) for this purpose.
