WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into an agreement with the Broome-Tioga Stormwater Coalition to regarding compliance with Phase II Federal regulations in Broome and Tioga Counties; and

WHEREAS, the Broome-Tioga Stormwater Coalition implements the Small municipal stormwater sewer systems (MS4) Stormwater Management Plans required by the New York State Department of Environmental Protection's Phase II Stormwater Regulations and oversees the utilization and expeditures of funds; and

WHEREAS, the City's cost to continue participation in the Broome-Tioga Stormwater Coalition is \$1,500; and

WHEREAS, funds are available for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:
