## **ORDINANCE**

entitled

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2020 CAPITAL BUDGET TO PROVIDE FOR ANTICIPATED REVENUE AND EXPENSES RELATED TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMNIC

WHEREAS, as a result of the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, the City of Binghamton will incur unexpected costs and expenses; and

WHEREAS, the State of New York has been granted Federal Emergency Management Agency disaster area funding, thus allowing for the State of New York to reimburse municipalities for a portion of their COVID-19 related expenses; and

WHEREAS, to account for these revenues and expenses, the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton finds it proper and necessary to amend the 2020 Capital budget; and;

WHEREAS, the budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on April 7, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

- Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2020 Capital budget to create, where necessary, and to fund revenue and expense budget lines as follows:
  - (i) \$ 15,625 increase to budget line A49999 from A599 (Appropriated Fund Balance)
  - (ii) \$ 15,625 increase to budget line A9950.59000 (Transfer to Capital)
  - (iii) \$ 15,625 increase to budget line H.45031 (Interfund Transfer)
  - (iv) \$ 93,750 increase to budget line H.44960 (FEMA Reveune DR4480)
  - (v) \$ 15,625 increase to budget line H.43960 (State Aid- FEMA DR4480)
  - (vi) \$125,000 increase to budget line H1210.xxxxx (CoronaVirus Expenses)

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
