A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH BARTON & LOGUIDICE, DPC FOR ADDITIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH REPAIRS TO THE FLOOR AND FOR THE RENOVATION OF THE CITY HALL FIRE STATION


WHEREAS, the City Engineer recommends the City enter into a Professional Services agreement with Barton & Loguidice, DPC for additional engineering services associated with repairs to the floor slab and the renovation of the fire station in City Hall into office and storage space; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost for such services is \$39,700; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a Professional Services agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Barton & Loguidice, DPC for additional engineering services associated with repairs to the floor slab and the renovation of the fire station in City Hall into office and storage space at a cost of \$29,900 (Design/Bidding), \$9,800 (CI Services) for a total of \$39,700 and funds shall be deducted from budget line H1620.525004.21716 (City Hall Improvements) for this purpose.
