WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is owner of certain real property located at 42 Bevier Street, Binghamton, New York, Tax Parcel No. 144.51-3-1 (the "Premises"); and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton granted a temporary easement over the Premises to the New York State Department of Transportation (NYS DOT), PIN 950061, by Permanent Resolution R17-83, dated ; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Estimate and Apportionment approved and recommended the easement on July 5, 2017; and

WHEREAS, in order to receive payment, the NYS DOT has requested the City to update its approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that City Council of the City of Binghamton hereby accepts \$500 in adjustment of the claim for a temporary easement on 42 Bevier Street, Binghamton, New York, and that the Mayor of the City of City of Binghamton be empowered to execute the Agreement and any subsequent papers which may be required to secure such payment.
