A RESOLUTION IDENTIFYING THAT A PORTION OF THE CITY'S GREEN ROOF PROJECT WILL BE PAID FROM THE 2016 BOND FOR VARIOUS CITY HALL IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton adopted Permanent Ordinance 16-13 dated February 17, 2016, entitled "A Bond Ordinance of the City of Binghamton New York, Adopted February 17, 2016, Authorizing Various Capital Improvements in and for the City, Stating the Estimated Maximum Cost for Such is \$14,335,000, Appropriating Said Amount for Such Purpose and Authorizing the Issuance of Bonds of the City in the Principal Amount of Not to Exceed \$14,335,000 to Finance Said Appropriation" and Permanent Resoultion 18-50, dated May 9, 2018, entitled "A Resolution Authorizing the City to Accept a \$1,600,000 Grant From the Environmental Facilities Corporations Green Innovation Grant Program for the City Hall Green Roof Project" (the "Grant"); and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the Green Roof Project is \$1,775,000, which exceeds the Grant amount by \$175,000; and

WHEREAS, the 2016 Bond Ordinance provides for "K. Various City Hall Improvements," with an Estimated Maximum Cost of \$750,000; and

WHEREAS, the amount of \$175,000 is available from the 2016 Bond for Various City Hall Improvements to fund the balalnce of the costs for the Green Roof Project; and

WHEREAS, the Green Roof Project is a necessary improvement to City Hall and it is in the best interest of the City to use an exising bond to avoid additional costs and expenses.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Council of the City of Binghamton identifies that the costs of the Green Roof Project in excess of the Grant, \$175,000, will be paid from the 2016 Bond for Various City Hall Improvements and that same is in the best interest of the City.
