
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE
FIRST WARD ACTION COUNCIL, INC. FOR
FY45 CDBG FUNDING IN AN AMOUNT NOT
TO EXCEED \$85,000 FOR THE SENIOR HOME
REPAIR PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into an agreement with First Ward Action Council, Inc. for Fiscal Year 45 Community Development Block Grant funding in an amount not to exceed \$85,000 for the Senior Home Repair Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with the First Ward Action Council, Inc. for Fiscal Year 45 Community Development Block Grant funding in an amount not to exceed \$85,000 for the Senior Home Repair Program; and that funds shall be deducted from budget line CD8668.533531.CDY45 (Senior Repair Program) for this purpose.
