A RESOLUTION TO AMEND PERMANENT
RESOLUTION 14-058 TO INCREASE THE
TOTAL AMOUNT FOR GHD

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton adopted Permanent Resolution 14-058 dated September 17, 2014, entitled "A Resolution authorizing the Mayor to enter into a professional services agreement with GHD for the design services for the restoration and rehabilitation of the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Treatment Plant"; and

WHEREAS, the legislation states that the agreement with GHD for design services related to the restoration and rehabilitation of the BJCJSTP is not to exceed \$1,266,000; and

WHEREAS, the written contract stated the estimated cost for certain work was \$595,00; and

WHEREAS, the detail stated the estimated cost for said work was \$640,00; and

WHEREAS, the result of the amount differentiation is \$45,000 and must be added to the total contract amount, increasing it from \$1,266,000 to \$1,311,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that Permanent Resolution 14-058 is hereby amended to increase the total amount from from \$1,266,000 to \$1,311,000.
