**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR  
TO ACCEPT THE HOMELAND SECURITY  
(SUASP) FEDERAL EXPLOSIVE DETECTION  
CANINE GRANT**

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton Police Bureau is eligible to receive a Homeland Security (SUASP) Federal Tactical Team Targeted Grant, Project CP18-1028-E00, in the amount of \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, the funds will be used to purchase canine explosive detection K-9, and equipment to include: response vehicle with emergency lights, 3 day box storage magazine, and kennel insert with an environmental monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, the grant does not require a local match; the grant funds will be administered by the Chief of Police, or his designee; and the estimated date of completion is August 31, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE , the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, as may be necessary to accept a Homeland Security (SUASP) Federal Tactical Team Targeted Grant, Project CP18-1028-E00, in the amount of \$50,000; and the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are directed to amend the budget accordingly; and be it further

RESOLVED that there is no City match for the acceptance of such funds; the Chief of Police, or his designee, shall be the grant project administrator, and that the estimated date of completion is August 31, 2020.
