AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2019 BINGHAMTON-JOHNSON CITY SEWAGE TREATMENT FACILITY BUDGET TO **INCREASE** THE APPROPRIATIONS CAPITAL REPAIRS TO REHABILITATE THE DETERIORATING WALLS OF BASINS 1 THROUGH 6

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton (the "City") is a joint owner of the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Treatment Facilities (the "BJCJSTF") with the Village of Johnson City (the "Village"); and

WHEREAS, the BJCJSTF is operated and maintained by the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Board (the "JSB") under a series of inter-municipal agreements between the City and the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City and the Board of Trustees of the Village approve the BJCJSTF budget; and

WHEREAS, the Comptroller/JSB Fiscal Officer and Business Manager of the BJCJSTF find it proper and necessary to amend the 2019 BJCJSTF budget, to increase the appropriations for capital repairs to rehabilitate the deteriorating walls of Settling Basins 1 through 6.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Council approves and directs the Comptroller/JSB Fiscal Officer to amend and make journal budget entries in the 2019 BJCJSTF budget to increase the appropriations for capital repairs to rehabilitate the deteriorating walls of Settling Basins 1 through 6.
