**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ACCEPT FIRST ROUND FUNDING FROM
THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA)
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$23,092,337**

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is eligible to receive first round funding from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) in the amount of \$23,092,337.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, to accept first round funding from the ARPA in the amount of \$23,092,337; and be it further

RESOLVED that said funds will be kept in a restricted fund balance account in the general fund, that no portion of said funds will be allocated or expensed until budget amendments are approved by City Council, and that all allocations and expenditures must comply with United States Treasury guidelines.
