WHEREAS, pursuant to Permanent Ordinance 21-43, dated, May 5, 2021, City Council approved an amendment to the 2021 Treasurer budget to defund one "Account Clerk II" [\$32,697] position and to fund a part-time "Clerk" position; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to void Permanent Ordinance 21-43.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Permanent Ordinance 21-43 is hereby declared null and void.

Section 2. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2021 Treasurer budget to void any amendments made pursuant to Permanent Ordinance 21-43.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
