**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2021 JOINT
SEWER PROJECT BUDGET FOR PERSONNEL
AND PROFESSIONAL SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton finds it proper and necessary to amend the 2021 Joint Sewer Project budget to transfer funds for the Project Analysis position and for Professional Services; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendment was approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on July 21, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2021 Joint Sewer Project budget to transfer funds for the Project Analysis position and for Professional Services as follows:

Transfer From (Decrease):

\$4,895 G9730.57000 (Sewer-Ban Interest)

\$8,900

Transfer To (Increase):

\$5,600 G8150.51000 (JT Sewer-
Proj.Analyst)

\$3,300 G8150.54410 (JT Sewer-Pro.Ser.)

\$8,900
