WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into an agreement with the various agencies for use of CVY46 funds for Homeless Emergency Solutions Grants; and

WHEREAS, the various agencies, to wit: VOA, YWCA, Fairview Recovery Services, Catholic Charities, and the Family Enrichment Network for services and in the amounts as set for the in Exhibit A annexed hereto; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated award amount is \$506,439.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with VOA, YWCA, Fairview Recovery Services, Catholic Charities, and the Family Enrichment Network for services and in the amounts as set for the in Exhibit A annexed hereto; and that funds shall be deducted from budget line CG8760.535002.CVY46 (EDW - Program) for this purpose.
