A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR  
TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE

CVY46 FUNDS TO SUPPORT AFFORDABLE

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into an agreement with the First Ward Action Council for use of CVY46 funds to support affordable housing development; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost for such services is not to exceed \$80,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with the First Ward Action Council for use of CVY46 funds to support affordable housing development, at a cost not to exceed \$80,000; and that funds shall be deducted from budget line CD8760.535002.CVY46 (EDW - Program) for this purpose.
