A RESOLUTION AMENDING A GRANT FROM LOCAL INITIATIVE SUPPORT CORPORATION FOR THE REMEDIATION AND RESALE OF ZOMBIE PROPERTIES WITHIN THE CITY OF BINGHAMTON AND SALARY FUNDING FOR VACANT PROPERTY EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton approved Permanent Resolution 19-60, dated August 7, 2019, in which the City was awarded a grant in the amount of \$250,000 from the Local Initiative Support Corporation ("LISC") as part of the New York State Housing Stabilization Fund, to support housing quality improvement and enforcement programs; and


WHEREAS, the City qualifies for a second round of grant funding in the amount of \$250,000 for remediation and resale of zombie properties within the City of Binghamton; salary funding for the Vacant Property Officer and Vacant Property Inspector, legal assistance, and travel and training; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to amend the grant as annexed hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the City of Binghamton is hereby authorized to accept a second round of grant funding in the amount of \$250,000 from LISC for remediation and resale of zombie properties within the City of Binghamton; salary funding for the Vacant Property Officer and Vacant Property Inspector, legal assistance, and travel and training; and to amend the budget as annexed hereto.
