### **MEMO**

To: Mayor and City Council From: Civil Service Commission

Date: July 28, 2021

Re: Residency Requirement

As stated in § C-13. Eligibility of the City of Binghamton Charter and Code, candidates must be residents of the City of Binghamton for employment. However, if no such candidates qualify a residency waiver can be sought by the Civil Service Commission for a candidate. Additionally, after an employee reaches permanent status under civil service they no longer need to seek a residency waiver to relocate outside City limits as long as they remain within Broome County.

Due to this provision, it has increasingly become difficult to attract qualified candidates and fill open positions. On average it is taking three-four months to fill open positions, many in which the Personnel Department is seeking residency waivers due to the lack of applications. Therefore, we are requesting § C-13. Eligibility be amended and expand residency to candidates within Broome County, with a preference to qualified City residents, without having to seek a waiver. Please see attached suggested changes to the Charter and Code.

By expanding the residency waiver, we believe that the Personnel Department will receive a higher number of qualified candidates applying for open positions and filling the positions at a faster rate which will help unstaffed departments.

No person shall be eligible for appointment or election to a City office or as a City employee, unless, at the time of his or her election or appointment, he or she is a bona fide resident of Broome Countysaid City, nor to any ward office unless he or she shall be at the time a bona fide resident elector of the ward for which he or she is elected or appointed, nor to the office of Councilperson unless he or she shall be at the time a bona fide resident elector of the Councilmanic district for which he or she is elected or appointed; and whenever any elected official of said City shall cease to be a resident of said City or of the ward or of the Councilmanic district for which he or she was elected the office or position shall thereby become vacant; and whenever any other employee of said City shall cease to be a resident of the County of Broome the position shall thereby become vacant. Notwithstanding the residency provisions of this section, the Municipal Civil Service Commission of the City of Binghamton shall have the power to waive the residence requirements hereinabove set forth, for City employees, except elected officials, under the following circumstances:

- A. Whenever it shall be established to the satisfaction of the Commission that there are no applicants residing in the City of Binghamton who meet the necessary requirements of education, professional training or experience for a position to be filled in the City of Binghamton, waiver may be granted to enable a nonresident to take a civil service examination for such position, but residents of the City of Binghamton shall be preferred in appointment from the list established after such examination prior to the appointment of any nonresident.
  - B. Notwithstanding the foregoing, any Broome County resident holding a position in the City of Binghamton under waiver, or otherwise, shall be entitled to equal rights, including those of tenure and promotion within the civil service of the City of Binghamton, as any other employee.
  - C. The Commission shall advise the Council of the City of Binghamton of all requests for a waiver of residency prior to making any determination. Final approval of such requests rests solely with the Commission. If a waiver is granted, the Commission shall forward its determination to the Council of the City of Binghamton, including the date the waiver of residence requirement was granted and the reason for the granting of the waiver.
  - D. The eligibility and residency requirements set forth in this section shall not apply to any member of the Binghamton Police Force heretofore appointed, whose residence was outside of Broome County prior to the date the eligibility and residency requirements of this section became effective.






