ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 124-39, PERSONNEL POLICIES, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BINGHAMTON, TO ADD TWO POSITIONS TO THE LIST OF 8 HOUR PER STANDARD WORK DAY EMPLOYEES
