**AN ORDINANCE TO ACCOUNT FOR LOST
REVENUE OF \$12,494,152 PER THE AMERICAN
RESCUE PLAN ACT GUIDELINES**

WHEREAS, the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton finds it proper and necessary to move \$12,494,152.00 of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds for lost revenue; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on August 18, 2021.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to move \$12,494,152.00 of the ARPA funds as follows:

- (i) \$12,494,152.00 increase revenue budget line A.44089.F0015 (Federal Aid – Stimulus)
- (ii) \$ 452,658.99 increase expense budget line A9901.59000.F0015 (Interfund Transfer)
- (iii) \$ 392,755.69 increase revenue budget line CP.45031 (Interfund Transfer)
- (iv) \$ 59,903.30 increase revenue budget line CL.45031 (Interfund Transfer)

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately.

I HEREBY CERTIFY that the above described funds are unencumbered and available
