AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2021
BUDGET TO ALLOCATE AMERICAN RESCUE
PLAN ACT FUNDS FOR AFFORDABLE
HOUSING

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2021 budget to increase the allocation of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds for affordable housing in the amount of \$2,386,749; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on September 1, 2021.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2021 budget to increase the allocation of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds for affordable housing in the amount of \$2,386,749 as follows:

- (i) \$2,386,749 increase revenue budget line A.44089.F0015 (Federal Aid-Other)
- (ii) \$2,386,749 increase expense budget line A8686.54756.F0015 (Affordable Housing)

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
