**A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT \$231,285 FROM
THE NYS DCJS GRANT TO IMPLEMENT THE
GIVE INITIATIVE AND FUND THE STCAC**

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is eligible to receive a grant in the amount of \$231,285 from NYS DCJS; and

WHEREAS, the grant will be used to implement the Gun Involved Violence Elimination (GIVE) initiative in efforts to stop violent crime, targeting firearm related crime, and aggravated assaults; and

WHEREAS, the grant will also fund aspects of the Southern Tier Crime Analysis Center (STCAC) including (i) full salary and fringe benefits for a Civilian Crime Analyst and BPD FIO investigator, and (ii) training expenses and overtime for crime reduction; and

WHEREAS, there is no required City match; that pending reimbursement, funding for the project shall be drawn from the general fund; that the head of Crime Prevention in the Binghamton Police Department will be the grant project manager; and that the anticipated date of project completion is June 30, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, to accept a grant in the amount of \$231,285 from NYS DCJS to implement the GIVE initiative and fund the STCAC.
