Items Considered

33 South Washington Street. Mary spoke to her surprise that the Planning Commission noted that the development will not affect traffic negatively. Mary noted she is a resident of the south side community and notes that Vestal Ave and S. Washington are used by many children and differently abled persons. The additional vehicles per hour in regards to the development would negatively affect quality of life. Additionally, Mary is opposed to the development utilizing "South Side Commons" area as an entrance. Mr. Kraham noted that the Planning Commission is a separate entity and the Traffic Board comments provide feedback for internal traffic as well as look at pedestrian circulation. The post office parking backing out to Mary St. is a problem. The board should look for alternatives to the parking arrangement.

Charles Street Parking. Board would like to like to study this issue longer. Hold until next Traffic Board Meeting April 9, 2020.

Culinary School Parking. Lost handicapped parking spot due to construction. Proposed to install meter for handicapped space, or make it a 2 free zone. Traffic recommends the following:

With the completion of the SUNY Broome Culinary and Event Center, Exchange Street, the Traffic Division was requested by Mr. Jared Kraham, Chairman, Traffic Board, to review the on street parking at that location for additional parking. It was also requested that a handicapped parking zone be inserted near the entrance to that facility.

The Traffic Division, upon reviewing the Traffic Code Book and existing on street parking recommends that the Traffic Code be amended as follows to that create additional parking zones.

Delete:

Section 22.2B Handicapped Parking Zone –

Exchange Street East Side - From 114 feet north of Congdon Place to 136 feet north.

Section 23 No Parking Anytime

Exchange Street East Side – From Congdon Place to 13 feet north.

Exchange Street East Side – From 247 feet north of Congdon Place to Court Street.

Section 22. Loading Zone

Exchange Street East Side – From 136 feet north of Congdon Street to 247 feet north

Section 43 Thirty Minute Parking Meter Zone

Exchange Street East Side - In front of the library on Exchange Street

Section 44 One Hour Parking Meter Zone -

Exchange Street East Side - from 13 feet north of Congdon Place to 114 feet north.

Insert:

Section 22.2B Handicapped Parking Zone

Exchange Street East Side – From 29 feet north of Congdon Place to 51 feet north.

Section 23 No Parking Anytime

Exchange Street East Side – from Congdon Place to 29 feet north.

Exchange Street East Side – From 277 feet north of Congdon Place to Court Street.

Section 22 Loading Zone

Exchange Street East Side – From 111 feet north of Congdon Street to 277 feet north.

Kiosk Parking Meter Zone -

Exchange Street East Side - from 51 feet north of Congdon Place to 111 feet north.
