**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2021 JT  
SEWER PROJECT BUDGET TO USE GENERAL  
FUND BALANCE FOR PERSONAL AND  
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton finds it proper and necessary to amend the 2021 JT Sewer Project budget to use General Fund Balance for Personal and Professional Services; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on October 20, 2021.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2021 JT Sewer budget for Personal Services and Professional Services as follows:

- (i) \$10,800 decrease the General Fund Balance
- (ii) \$ 5,000 increase expense budget line G8150.51000 (Per.Ser- Proj.Analyst)
- (iii) \$ 5,800 increase expense budget line G8150.54410 (Pro.Ser- Proj.Asst.Ser.)

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
