**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2021
BUDGET FOR LEGAL SERVICES IN THE LAW

WHEREAS, the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton finds it proper and necessary to amend the 2021 budget for legal services in the Law Department; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on October 20, 2021.

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend 2021 budget to fund legal services in the Law Department as follows:

Transfer From (Decrease):


\$20,000 A6989.51000 (Per.Ser-Director)
