FUNDS


WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into agreements with various small businesses for distribution of COVID-19 Cares Act Funds; and

WHEREAS, the businesses approved for assistance are Vista Property Management at a cost not to exceed \$7,500; Hair by Simone at a cost not to exceed \$2,000; and Fuller Sons and Daughters Gift Shop at a cost not to exceed \$2,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Vista Property Management at a cost not to exceed \$7,500; Hair by Simone at a cost not to exceed \$2,000; and Fuller Sons and Daughters Gift Shop at a cost not to exceed \$2,000; and that funds shall be deducted from budget line CD8760.535005.CVY45 (EDW-PROGRAM-BUSINESS ASST) for this purpose.
