A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT \$330,000 FROM THE ENVIRONMENTAL FACILITIES CORPORATION GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is eligible to receive a grant in the amount of \$330,000 from the Environmental Facilities Corporation Green Infrastructure Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the grant will be used for the City of Binghamton Deco District Green Infrastructure Project; and

WHEREAS, there is a local match of \$33,000 to be paid from the Department of State (DOS) Urban Revitalization Initiative (URI) C1001415 Downtown Entertainment & Cultural Organizations (DECO) District grant; that pending reimbursement, funding for the project shall be drawn from the general fund; that the Director of PHCD and the City Engineer will be the grant project managers; and that the anticipated date of project completion is December 2022.
