## **ORDINANCE**

entitled

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BINGHAMTON, CHAPTER 124, PERSONNEL POLICIES

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton wishes to amend the City Code to modify various sections of Chapter 124, Personnel Policies.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Code of the City of Binghamton, Chapter 124, *Personnel Policies*, is hereby amended as follows:

- **F.** [New] Employees who have retired from the City of Binghamton (not just collected their retirement from NYSLRS) and carry health insurance into retirement are eligible to opt out of the retiree health insurance plan and return to the plan <u>one</u> time as long as they provide proof of insurance coverage during the entire period they were not covered by the City's plan.
- **G.** [New] Employees who have retired from the City of Binghamton (not just collected their retirement from NYSLRS) and did not carry health insurance into retirement are eligible to return to the plan as long as they provide proof of insurance coverage during the entire period they were not covered by the City's plan. These retired employees may opt out again but will <u>not</u> be eligible to return to the City's plan a second time.
