A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is eligible for a FY 2021 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program grant ("JAG Grant") in the amount of \$30,435 to be used to fund police officer patrols in City Parks in the summer; and

WHEREAS, the JAG Grant will require a Memorandum of Understanding with Broome County; and

WHEREAS, the JAG Grant does not require a local match; the grant funds will be administered by the Crime Prevention Lieutenant or his designee; and the estimated date of completion will be September 30, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE , the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, as may be necessary to accept a FY 2021 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program grant in the amount of \$30,435 and to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Broome County establishing the City of Binghamton as the grant administering municipality.
