a. Approval to pursue contract with Police Psychologist, Douglas Thompson, due to changes in Civil Service Law, presented by Leana Testani

Board agreed to designate Dr. Thompson as the preferred Civil Service psychologist for the City of Binghamton and that the City can move forward in securing a contract.
