A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR  
TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION AND TO  
ACCEPT A NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF  
COMMUNITY RENEWAL COMMUNITY  
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT –CV (COVID-  
19 RESPONSE)

WHEREAS, the New York State Office of Community Renewal (the “OCR”) has announced availability of funding under the CDBG-CV program to provide grants to prevent, prepare for, and respond to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the Binghamton Housing Authority has requested that the City apply for the OCR funding to replace outdated elevators in North Shore Tower 2 (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the Project, if awarded funding, will result in substantial benefit to City residents; and

WHEREAS, the City held a public hearing on December 8, 2021, to obtain citizens’ views regarding the CDBG program as administered by OCR.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to submit a grant application on behalf of the City in an amount not to exceed \$500,000 to the OCR; and be it further

RESOLVED that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a grant agreement between the City and the OCR and all related documents associated with the OCR grant, including entering into a grant agreement with the Binghamton Housing Authority for the implementation of the Project, all such documents to be subject to review and approval by the Office of Corporation Counsel; and be it further

RESOLVED that the Mayor is hereby designated as the Certifying Officer responsible for all activities associated with the federal environmental review process to be completed in conjunction with the Project.
