**A RESOLUTION AMENDING PERMANENT
RESOLUTION 21-88 TO ACKNOWLEDGE
ARPA FUNDING FOR PREMIUM PAY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Permanent Resolution 21-88, dated November 3, 2021, City Council approved a collective bargaining agreement between the City of Binghamton and the Civil Service Employees Association, Inc., AFSCME, Local 100, AFL-CIO, City of Binghamton Unit 6151, of the Broome County Local 804 ("CSEA Inc.") for calendar years 2022-2024; and

WHEREAS, the collective bargaining agreement provides for Premium Pay defined as "Pandemic Considerations" for a total of up to \$10,000; and

WHEREAS, prior to approval of the collective bargaining agreement it was discussed that such "Pandemic Considerations" would be deducted from American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds; and

WHEREAS, the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton finds it proper and necessary to amend Permanent Resolution 21-88 to acknowledge the use of ARPA funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE, that Permanent Resolution 21-88 is hereby amended to add a second RESOLVED paragraph as follows:

RESOLVE, that the attached agreement between the City of Binghamton and the CSEA, Inc. for the calendar years 2022-2024 is approved; and be it further

[New] RESOLVED that Premium Pay defined as "Pandemic Considerations" in the 2022-2024 agreement for a total of up to \$10,000 shall be deducted from ARPA funds.
