**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2022
FINANCE, LAW, AND CONTINGENCY
BUDGETS FOR TEMPORARY PERSONAL
SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton finds it proper and necessary to amend the 2022 Finance, Law, and Contingency budgets for temporary and personal services; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on January 19, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2022 Finance, Law, and Contingency budgets for temporary personal services as follows:

Transfer From (Decrease):

\$25,000 A1990.55000 (Contingency)

Transfer To (Increase):


\$20,000 A1310.51800 (Temp.Ser.)

5,000 A1420.51800 (Temp.Ser.)

\$25,000
