AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2022
MAYOR BUDGET TO INCREASE THE
ANNUAL SALARY OF THE ASSISTANT TO
THE MAYOR FOR YOUTH & NEIGHBORHOOD
AFFAIRS TO \$45,329

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2022 Mayor budget to increase the annual salary of the Assistant to the Mayor for Youth and Neighborhood Affairs from \$43,346.00 to \$45,329.00; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds in the existing budget line because the position was vacant until January 24, 2022; and


WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on February 23, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2022 Mayor budget to increase budget line A1210.51000 (Assistant to the Mayor for Youth and Neighborhood Affairs) from \$43,346.00 to \$45,329.00.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
