AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2021
BINGHAMTON-JOHNSON CITY JOINT
SEWAGE BOARD BUDGET TO TRANSFER
FUNDS FOR CHEMICALS, SLUDGE, AND
WASTE HAULING AND WATER EXPENSES

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton (the "City") is a joint owner of the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Treatment Facilities (the "BJCJSTF") with the Village of Johnson City (the "Village"); and

WHEREAS, the BJCJSTF is operated and maintained by the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Board (the "JSB") under a series of inter-municipal agreements between the City and the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City and the Board of Trustees of the Village approve the BJCJSTF budget; and

WHEREAS, the JSB has requested to amend the 2021 BJCJSTF budget to transfer appropriated funds for chemicals, sludge, waste hauling, and water expenses.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Council approves and directs the Comptroller/JSB Fiscal Officer to amend and make journal entries in the 2021 BJCJSTF budget to transfer appropriated funds for chemicals, sludge, waste hauling, and water expenses as follows:

Transfer From (Decrease):

\$89,700 J8130.55000 (Contingency)


Transfer To (Increase):

\$57,500 J8130.54150 (Chemicals)
25,000 J8130.54804 (Sludge/Waste)
7,200 J8130.54221 (Water)

\$89,700

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
