**ORDINANCE**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2021  
BINGHAMTON-JOHNSON CITY JOINT  
SEWAGE BOARD BUDGET TO ADJUST THE  
APPROPRIATIONS FOR BAF LEGAL  
SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton (the “City”) is a joint owner of the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Treatment Facilities (the “BJCJSTF”) with the Village of Johnson City (the “Village”); and

WHEREAS, the BJCJSTF is operated and maintained by the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Board (the “JSB”) under a series of inter-municipal agreements between the City and the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City and the Board of Trustees of the Village approve the BJCJSTF budget; and

WHEREAS, the JSB has requested an amendment to the 2021 BJCJSTF budget to increase the annual appropriations for BAF Legal Services by \$900,000 and to decrease Reimburse Village Debt Service by \$340,000, decrease Reimburse City Debt Service by \$260,000, decrease Contingency by \$136,000, decrease Health Insurance – Retirees by \$130,000 and decrease Maintenance Agreements by \$34,000 and further direct the City Comptroller to encumber any 2021 unspent balance into the 2022 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Council approves and directs the Comptroller/JSB Fiscal Officer to amend and make journal budget entries in the 2021 BJCJSTF budget to adjust the appropriations for BAF Legal Services by \$900,000 and to decrease Reimburse Village Debt Service by \$340,000, decrease Reimburse City Debt Service by \$260,000, decrease Contingency by \$136,000, decrease Health Insurance – Retirees by \$130,000 and decrease Maintenance Agreements by \$34,000 and further direct the City Comptroller to encumber any 2021 unspent balance into the 2022 Budget as follows:

Transfer From (Decrease):

Transfer To (Increase):


