A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH
NYSDOT FOR SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT
NO. 1 FOR THE MAIN ST. CORRIDOR STUDY
AND IMPROVEMENTS, PIN 9754.37

WHEREAS, pursuant to Permanent Resolution 17-58, dated May 3, 2017, the City entered into an agreement with New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) for the Main St. Corridor Study and Improvements, PIN 9754.37; and


WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into Supplemental Agreement No. 1 with NYSDOT for the estimated costs of ROW incidentals and ROW acquisitions.

WHEREAS, the estimated costs of ROW incidentals and ROW acquisitions was increased to \$69,930, and the City will be reimbursed 100% with Federal funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into Supplemental Agreement No. 1, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with NYSDOT for the estimated costs of ROW incidentals and ROW acquisitions, at an estimated cost of \$69,930, fully reimbursable with Federal funds; and that funds shall be deducted from budget line H5110.525213.20817 (Main St. Corridor Study and Improvements) for this purpose.
