ORDINANCE

entitled

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2022
BINGHAMTON-JOHNSON CITY JOINT
SEWAGE BUDGET TO TRANSFER FUNDS FOR
AN ADDITIONAL OPERATOR I/TRAINEE
POSITION AND DEFUND ONE OPERATOR III

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton (the "City") is a joint owner of the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Treatment Facilities (the "BJCJSTF") with the Village of Johnson City (the "Village"); and

WHEREAS, the BJCJSTF is operated and maintained by the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Board (the "JSB") under a series of inter-municipal agreements between the City and the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City and the Board of Trustees of the Village approve the BJCJSTF budget; and

WHEREAS, the JSB has requested to amend the 2022 BJCJSTF budget to (i) defund one Operator III position and to create and fund one Operator I/Operator Trainee position at an annual salary up to \$55,037; (ii) defund one Operator III position; (iii) reduce State Retirement, Social Security, and Workers' Compensation accordingly, and (iv) to transfer the balance to contingency.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Council approves and directs the Comptroller/JSB Fiscal Officer to amend and make journal entries in the 2022 BJCJSTF budget to adjust budget line J8130.51000 (Personal Services) to add one Operator I/Operator Trainee position at an annual salary up to \$55,037.

Section 2. That the Council approves and directs the Comptroller/JSB Fiscal Officer to amend and make journal budget entries in the 2022 BJCJSTF budget to (i) defund one Operator III position for 20 pay periods starting on March 05, 2022; and (ii) fund one Operator I/Operator Trainee position to be funded in 2022 for 20 pay periods starting on March 05, 2022; (iii) reduce State Retirement, Social Security, and Workers' Compensation accordingly, and (iv) to transfer the balance to contingency as follows:
