**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2022
CENTRAL SERVICES BUDGET FOR THE
POSITION OF STORESKEEPER**

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Agent and Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2022 Central Services budget to increase the hourly rate of the Storeskeeper position; and

WHEREAS, the Teamsters contract requires the wage to go to 90% of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the new rate of pay will be \$21.50 per hour effective March 12, 2022; and

WHEREAS, there are funds in the existing budget line available for the new rate of pay because the position has been vacant since January 2022 and the remaining funds will be transferred from Health Insurance; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on March 9, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2022 Central Services budget to increase the hourly rate of the Storeskeeper position, budget line A1660.51000 (Per.Ser.Storeskeeper), to 21.50 per hour, effective March 12, 2022, for a total annual increase of \$7,516; to be funded (i) from the existing budget line, \$6,796, because the position has been vacant since January 2022 and (ii) from Health Insurance as follows:

Transfer From (Decrease):


\$720 A9060.58000C (Health Insurance)

Transfer To (Increase):

\$720 A1660.51000 (Per.Ser.Storeskeeper)

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect as of March 12, 2022.
