ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2022 CODE ENFORCEMENT BUDGET TO ALLOCATE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDS FOR A NEW CODE INSPECTOR

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to (i) amend the 2022 Code Enforcement budget to create an expense budget line for a Code Inspector position at an annual salary of \$33,632, together with benefits and related expenses, effective as of April 1, 2022, to support neighborhood stabilization efforts in distressed areas, and (ii) allocate American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds in the amount of \$44,420 for same; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on March 23, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to (i) amend the 2022 Code Enforcement budget to create expense budget line A8664.51000.F0015 (Per.Ser-Code Inspector) at an annual salary of \$33,632, together with benefits and related expenses, effective as of April 1, 2022, to support neighborhood stabilization efforts in distressed areas, and (ii) allocate American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds in the amount of \$44,420 for same from April 1, 2022, to the end of the year as follows:

- \$44,420 increase revenue budget line A.44089.F0015 (Federal Aid-ARPA)
- \$25,500 increase expense budget line A8664.51000.F0015 (Per.Ser-Code Ins.) (ii)
- \$ 2,425 increase expense budget line A9010.58000A.F0015 (NYS Retirement-(iii) ARPA)
- \$ 1,950 increase expense budget line A9030.58000B.F0015 (Social Security-(iv) ARPA)
- \$14,545 increase expense budget line A9060.58000C.F0015 (Health Ins.-ARPA) (v)

That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately. Section 2.
