ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 124-39.A, PERSONNEL POLICIES, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BINGHAMTON, TO REMOVE THE ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT (TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS) FROM THE 8 HOUR STANDARD WORK DAY AND TO REDUCE THE ANNUAL SALARY ACCORDINGLY

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton wishes to amend the Code of the City of Binghamton, Chapter 124, *Personnel Policies*, Article VIII, *Officers and Employees not covered by Collective Bargaining Agreements*, §124-39.A, *Standard Work Day*, to remove E. Administrative Assistant (to the Commissioner of Public Works); and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Assistant to the Commissioner of Public Works will be a 7 hour position, effective March 7, 2022; and

WHEREAS, this reduction in hours will reduce the annual salary of the Administrative Assistant (to the Commissioner of Public Works) in the 2022 Public Works Administrative budget from \$45,293 to \$39,631; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on March 23, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Code of the City of Binghamton, Chapter 124, *Personnel Policies*, Article VIII, *Officers and Employees not covered by Collective Bargaining Agreements*, §124-39.A, *Standard Work Day*, is hereby amended to remove E. Administrative Assistant (to the Commissioner of Public Works).

Section 2. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2022 Public Works Administrative budget to reduce the annual salary of the Administrative Assistant (to the Commissioner of Public Works), budget line A1490.51000 (Per.Ser-Admin.Asst.), from \$45,293 to \$39,631, effective as of March 7, 2022.

Section 3. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2022 Public Works Administrative budget to transfer the excess funds from the Administrative Assistant (to the Commissioner of Public Works) position to contingency as follows:

Transfer From (Decrease):


\$4,573.80 A1490.51000 (Per.Ser-Admin.Asst.)
