AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND PERMANENT
ORDINANCE 22-36 AND AMEND THE 2021
BINGHAMTON-JOHNSON CITY JOINT
SEWAGE BOARD BUDGET TO ADJUST THE
APPROPRIATIONS FOR BAF LEGAL
SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton (the "City") is a joint owner of the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Treatment Facilities (the "BJCJSTF") with the Village of Johnson City (the "Village"); and

WHEREAS, the BJCJSTF is operated and maintained by the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Board (the "JSB") under a series of inter-municipal agreements between the City and the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City and the Board of Trustees of the Village approve the BJCJSTF budget; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Permanent Ordinance 22-36, dated February 23, 2022, City Council approved an amendment to the 2021 Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Board budget to adjust the appropriations for BAF Legal Services; and

WHEREAS, the JSB has requested an amendment to the 2021 BJCJSTF budget to increase the annual appropriations for BAF Legal Services by \$900,000 and to decrease Reimburse Village Debt Service by \$340,000, decrease Reimburse City Debt Service by \$260,000, decrease Contingency by \$136,000, decrease Health Insurance – Retirees by \$89,000, decrease Electricity by \$41,000 and decrease Maintenance Agreements by \$34,000 and further direct the City Comptroller to encumber any 2021 unspent balance into the 2022 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. The original Ordinance, Permanent Ordinance 22-36, contained an error in ledger account numbers (shown below) and should be rescinded.
