AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2022
PERSONNEL & CIVIL SERVICE BUDGET TO
ADD AND FUND A CIVIL SERVICE
ADMINISTRATOR POSITION AND DEFUND
AN ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF PERSONNEL &
SAFETY POSITION AND AMEND THE CODE
ACCORDINGLY

WHEREAS, the Director of Personnel & Safety and Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2022 Personnel & Civil Service budget to defund the "Assistant Personnel & Safety Director" position and to add a "Civil Service Administrator" position at an annual salary of \$55,003; and

WHEREAS, the "Civil Service Administrator" position was approved by the Civil Service Commission on April 27, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton wishes to amend the Code of the City of Binghamton, Chapter 124, *Personnel Policies*, Article VIII, *Officers and Employees not covered by Collective Bargaining Agreements*, §124-39, *Definition*, Section 2. *Management Tested*, to replace R. Assistant Director of Personnel & Safety (a/k/a Assistant Personnel & Safety Director) with Civil Service Administrator; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton wishes to amend the Code of the City of Binghamton, Chapter 124, *Personnel Policies*, Article VIII, *Officers and Employees not covered by Collective Bargaining Agreements*, §124-39.A, *Standard Work Day*, to remove Q. Assistant Director of Personnel & Safety (a/k/a Assistant Personnel & Safety Director); and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on May 4, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2022 Personnel & Civil Service budget to (i) defund an "Assistant Director of Personnel & Safety (8)" position, (ii) add a "Civil Service Administrator" position at an annual salary of \$55,003; and (iii) fund the new "Civil Service Administrator" position from May 16 through December 31, 2022 as follows:



Section 2. That the Code of the City of Binghamton, Chapter 124, *Personnel Policies*, Article VIII, *Officers and Employees not covered by Collective Bargaining Agreements*, §124-39, *Definition*, Section 2. *Management Tested*, is hereby amended to replace R. Assistant Director of Personnel & Safety (a/k/a Assistant Personnel & Safety Director) with Civil Service Administrator.

Section 3. That the Code of the City of Binghamton, Chapter 124, *Personnel Policies*, Article VIII, *Officers and Employees not covered by Collective Bargaining Agreements*, §124-39.A, *Standard Work Day*, is hereby amended to remove Q. Assistant Director of Personnel & Safety (a/k/a Assistant Personnel & Safety Director).

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect May 16, 2022
