A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT \$7,164 FROM THE GOVERNOR'S TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE TO FUND POLICE OVERTIME

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is eligible to receive \$7,164 from the Governor's Traffic Safety Committee to fund Police overtime for traffic safety in the City of Binghamton, as well as involve Binghamton Police Officers to engage with the community in a positive manor to keep pedestrians, drivers, and passengers safe while traveling; and
