A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO AMEND THE AGREEMENT WITH
GREATER OPPORTUNITIES FOR BROOME
AND CHENANGO, INC. FOR USE OF FY47
CDBG AND ESG FUNDS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Permanent Resolution 22-07, dated February 9, 2022, the City of Binghamton entered into an agreement with various agencies for the use of FY47 Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") and Emergency Selter Grant ("ESG") funds; and


WHEREAS, the agreement with Greater Opportunities for Broome & Chenango, Inc. awarded FY47 CDBG funds in an amount not to exceed \$20,000 for parking lot renovations; and

WHEREAS, the Manager, HUD Administration and Housing, recommends a change in scope of the agreement from parking lot renovations to carpet replacement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to amend the agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Greater Opportunities for Broome & Chenango, Inc. for the use of FY47 CDBG funds from parking lot renovations to carpet replacement; and that this amendment does not change the total amount not to exceed \$20,000 and the funding source remains CD8662.533552.CDY47 (Human Services Capital Set Aside) for this purpose.
